## Speaking Assessment

- Speaking task 1: Interview (5 marks)

Students will randomly select and answer 5 questions from 10 question related to Unit 1 – 3. Time is limited to 45 seconds for each questions. Questions will be given to students one week before the test date.

- Speaking task 2: Interview (5 marks)

Students will randomly select and answer 5 questions from 10 question related to Unit 1 - 3. Time is limited to 45 seconds for each questions. Questions will **NOT** be given to students at this time.

## - Speaking task 3: One-minute Speech (10 marks)

Students perform a short talk individually by selecting topic from unit 1 -6 i.e. Interests, Sports and exercises, Appearance, Weather, Indoor Activities, Things in a home, Household chores, Healthy habits, Types of TV shows and Television.
