Very good to be here. Thank you so much for being here.

I've been begging to come here. I've been begging to ask all the time.

I've seen your show and I was like, wow, I wanna go there. and they're like, no, you're busy.

And I said, I'm not! I was doing something on my instagram. We thought you were too busy.

I'm just very free right now. So what have you been up to?

Before anything happens, I got you this. It's a very small goft game.

You're the first guest ever who has given me anything.

Why is your English so good? I studied in an international school when I was a kid. Very young, like 4th and 5th Grade.

Do you get many opportunities to use English in your everyday life?

Like nowadays? A little bit when I contact for work. Other than that, normal life...

I have some foreigner friends. And I ..guess that's it. I watch movies and I sing in English.

I have heard that you lived in Hong Kong for a while as a child. Is that right?

My Dad got a scholarship. He asked the church if we go along with him.

'Coz it was two years and he said he surely was going to be lonely so..

They agreed and we tagged along.. and at first, we had no future whatsoever.

We were like, I don't know how we're gonna live there.

Yes, I was young and my parents worked for church...and it's not a lot of pay.

We're not rich, and we were thinking... My mom was like, ok, how are you gonna study there?

Because we wouldn't be able to afford international school. So my Mum was like, (คุณแม่เลยบอกกว่า..)

Ok maybe we'll just home-school you. And we were like, (เราก็เลยแบบ) ok.

We were young, we didn't know anything back then ok, whatever (อะไรก็ได้), we were just (เราก็แค่)

We were so excited. When we got there it's like... we're so blessed that my Dad's study place..

I don't know what it's called, like an institute maybe. And it's was up on the mountain and at the bottom of the mountain there's this home school for American missionaries.

How was your English back then? It was...But it went well (มันไปด้วยดี)

About three months and I could catch up with my friends (ก็ตามเพื่อนทัน) So it took you three months?

To be able to speak English fluently. I don't know if it was fluently (ก็ไม่รู้ว่าคุณลองใหม่) I know I could understand most of it.

It's easier to start young. They don't judge.

You told me that you tried to imitate other people. There would be some words I didn't understand,

but I only remembered the sound. Like when the teacher says, Ok,, take out a piece of paper.

and I think...Ok, I don't know what that is sounds like pizza, so whenever there's pizza, I take out paper.

Whenever the teacher says, (เมื่อไหร่ที่ครูพูดว่า) who wants to answer, raise your hand. I think I didn't know it was...but I know that if this word comes up, I have to do this. When I later found out (แต่พอมารู้ทีหลัง) it was not hard. มันก็ไม่ยาก

It was like (อ้อ) it was this.

Right, let's talk about singing มาพูดถึงเรื่องร้องเพลงกัน Do you that singing helps you with practicing your English?

I think it did. I think the way that I love singing that's how I became so good at imitating things.

Maybe it's my ears or my tongue. something worked together really well that helped me pick up things really fast.

I can listen to you all day because you have such a beautiful voice.

It's now time to play in playtime! In the first playtime, we're going to play, What is it?

which color box would you like? Do I eat now? Give me some clues.

(บอกใบ้ให้หน่อย)

One of Carabao's songs I think. I don't know what it's called.

when he came to Thailand for the first time I took him to Siam Square.

He saw milk tea with pearls or something. and he was stunned (แล้วเขาก็งง)

Why do you put pearls in tea? It was really difficult for me to explain to him.

Tapioca (มันสำปะหลัง) If you see the word, you know it. They need to learn something from us.

Alright, Let's talk about your music. How did you become so passionate about music?

I guess it started from the genes from my parents.

How did you find out that you had the voice? For music, it started when I was nine.

I started playing the piano. 'Cuz I saw my Mum playing and I was like... (แบบว่า)

Just like that? (อย่างนั้นเลยหรือ) She sent me to learn piano and I was like, ok I was fun.

For the singing part, I didn't know until I was... My friends, they said your voice is good,

and you can play the guitar and sing, Really, It was good? I never knew I was good.

When I was a kid, everyone all around me sang ok. It wasn't like singer good, but they can sing.

Then I thought I was like that. So I'd say, compliments are very important coz without my friends telling me that I was good,

I would be there. I wouldn't realise that I was good. And then I started going on competitions

Let's talk about this amazing song. For those you of who have never heard of the song. It helped so many people.

It's like throwing a rock in the pond or something. It just spreads out and all the people who were troubled.

They told their friends. When they see their friends in trouble, they say, listen to this song, it will help you.

And I got feedback like, probably five people that came to me they said, thank you so much, you saves me from committing suicide.

The song is about letting go if you ask me. (เพลงนี้มันเกี่ยวกับการปล่อยวางนะ)
You don't realise that you've been hurting yourself.

(เขาไม่ตระหนักกันว่าเรากำลังทำร้ายตัวเองอยู่) Well done, you. I won't take the credit. He wrote it so well because it's so easy to understand.

It's like something you already know that this is the truth of the world. but... you just can't do it (แต่ก็ ทำไม่ได้อยู่ดี)

What do you think about when you sing? I think I'm a actor. I feel like I'm the person in the song.

I think singing and acting are not that different. You have to pretend to be the person that you...reflect, you show people.

Do you have any advice for kids who want to sing so well?(มีคำแนะนำอะไรไหมสำหรับเด็กที่อยากร้องเพลงเก่ง)

One of my students once asked me this question: What do I need to do? I've no feelings when I sing.

People don't really feel it.

I see that a lot, too, contestants usually when they sing.

Well of course, everyone's experience is different, right? If you understand this much, just show it this much.

Do you ever mix up any of your tunes with songs by other artists?

It's usually the other way around. (ที่จริงมันเป็นในทางกลับกัน) People would tell me.. once I went to work, and I was waiting in karaoke room and this staff walked in and said, I love your song. And I was like, (ฉันก็แบบ) thank you.

Look at the time (ดูเวลาสิ) Lets playtime again. "well known musical artists"

She was very famous when you were young. She started out very innocent, now she's one of the ...

They're duo, Thai duo, you know them. Newer generation,

She came back with her new album that won a lot of Grammy's.

How was it? (เป็นไงบ้าง) Well, you watch it so you know.... I have never done it (ฉันยังไม่เคยทำเลย)

Let's talk about something fun and creative. The Question is, if you were a rose, what color would you be?

Why is that? (ทำไมล่ะ) One is that, it's weird (อย่างแวก มันแปลกดี) There's not really a green rose. That's all (แค่นั้นแหละ)

You know what? (รู้ไหม) Being weird is a wonderful thing. (การเป็นคนแปลกประหลาดเป็นสิ่งที่ดี) Embrace it (จงอ้าแขนรับมันไว้เถิด)

Embrace who you are (จงรักสิ่งที่คุณเป็น)

We have to talk about this because I came across this on your Instagram that you went to see a concert.

Somehow (แล้วคุณก็) you got to sing in the concert. What happened?

Well, Thing is, actually..(ก็ที่จริงแล้ว)

but at the start of the concert, he said, OK, I'm gonna... Who want to sing with me?

I'm gonna go down and get one of you (ผมจะลงไปพาคูณมาสักคน) to sing with me, and I'm like...ฉัน แบบว่า

He's gonna do that?!! I want to sing with him, and started talking with my friends like

I'm here, how am I gonna....? You think I can? (เธอว่าฉันทำได้หรอ) You're Rose, aren't you?

So I just ran down. You know it's a concert and I'm in the business so I'm like,

I might know someone that might be able to help me. And I looked around for the staff.

I don't know anyone. So I stood there and I just tried to look at him. I look at him really hard.

I stared (ฉันจ้องเลยแหละ) I'm trying to hypnotise him. And he's just looking left and right.

'Anyone wanna sing with me?' and this guy stood up and sang with him.

And he waved his hand around (แล้วเขาก็โบกมือไปมา) I was like (ฉันก็) so he spotted me. (แล้วเขาก็เห็นฉัน)

Eventually(ในที่สุด) he saw you. And then he's like, (แล้วเขาก็แบบ) OK, you'd better be good. (ต้องทำให้ดีนะ)

You nailed it (คุณทำได้ดีมาก) The funny thing is, because all of this songs I know lots of the songs but the only song that

I could sing without forgetting the lyrics is the song. So I went and I asked If I could sing this song.

Is your tongue flexible? Oh my goodness! What's that? (อะไรอะ) My hands can fart. (มือฉันผายลมได้)
